UAE NEWS

- CBUAE stated that demand for bank credit in the country is growing, supported by economic stability and strong investments, despite rising interest rates.
- SCCI has discussed ways to enhance trade and investment cooperation between the business community in the emirate and its counterpart in Nepal.
- Shareholders of Borouge approved an interim cash dividend of \$650 million for the H1 of 2024, representing an annualised dividend yield of 6.30%.
- Dubai is set to host the inaugural edition of Logimotion at DWTC from 10th to 11th Dec, 2024, where leaders in the fields of mobility and logistics will come together.
- Etihad Water and Electricity has officially inaugurated four new facilities, with total investment of AED 422 mln advancing its strategic goals across Northern Emirates.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Securities Commission Malaysia (SC) has urged stakeholders in Islamic finance to collaborate and lay the groundwork for the future of Islamic fintech.
- Co-opbank Pertama Malaysia Bhd will be issuing a Structured Covered Sukuk of up to RM5 billion as one of the strategies to remain in a consistent and stable financial position.

GCC NEWS

- The solid performance of GCC banks in the first half of the year indicates that "good performance should continue throughout 2024," absent any unexpected shock: S&P Global Ratings.
- Saudi Central Bank penned an agreement with Samsung to provide access to Samsung Pay service in the Kingdom during the fourth quarter of 2024.

COMMODITIES

- Gold was little changed as investors kept to the sidelines ahead of U.S. payrolls data that could provide more clues on the size of an expected rate cut this month.
- Oil prices edged up after plunging to multi-month lows previously as major producers may delay an output increase planned for next month and U.S. inventories fell.

FOREX NEWS

- USD dipped as traders ramped up bets for a supersized rate cut from the Fed, with a notable outperformer from JPY as concerns over the U.S. economy's growth outlook resurfaced.
- AUD held steady after the country's central bank stuck to its hawkish guidance on interest rates despite soft economic numbers, helping to offset risk aversion in global markets.
