- Abu Dhabi Islamic Bank (ADIB) reported a 16% YoY rise in FY 2024 net profit at AED 6.1 billion (\$1.6 billion). Net profit for Q4 2024 was AED 1.46 billion, 2% lower YoY.
- 5% growth for UAE's infrastructure sector in 2025 driven by ongoing & upcoming projects in development. UAE one of the most active construction markets regionally and globally.
- Emirates NBD posts flat Q4 profit as investment offsets higher income. Net profit for the October-to-December period was AED 4 billion (\$1.09 billion).
- Sharjah Chamber has unveiled the 'Business Impact' Podcast during ACRES 2025, to spotlight Sharjah as a prime destination for business management and investment.
- Alef Group, achieved a significant milestone during the ACRES 2025 Sharjah Real Estate Exhibition by signing 1,006 SPAs with a total value of AED 1,371,547,922.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Bahrain: CBB's monthly issue of the Ijara Sukuk, has been oversubscribed by 563%. BD 146.496 million were received for the BD 26 million issue, with maturity of 182 days.
- NBO Muzn Islamic Banking has launched its innovative Corporate Running Wakala Finance Product, offering a Shariahcompliant alternative to conventional overdraft facilities.

GCC NEWS

- National Bank of Kuwait the Gulf country's largest lender, posted a net profit of 600.1 million dinars (\$1.9 billion) in FY 2024, up 7% YoY due to higher net interest income and lower provisions.
- Oman: CBO issues treasury bills worth OMR52.80 million (\$137.ImIn). The value of the allotted treasury bills amounted to RO 2 million, for a maturity period of 28 days.

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices little changed as market participants awaited the U.S. rate verdict, while the spotlight was also on President Donald Trump's trade policies amid fresh tariff threats.
- Oil prices steadied as investors weighed the impact of potential U.S. tariffs on Canadian and Mexican imports, while largely shrugging off an increase in U.S. weekly crude inventory.

FOREX NEWS

- CAD edged lower ahead of an expected rate cut by the Bank of Canada and as the threat of U.S. trade tariffs drew renewed focus, leading to broad-based gains for the American currency.
- AUD hit a one-week low as a surprisingly soft reading on domestic inflation stoked wagers on a near-term cut in interest rates, sending bond yields lower.
